PM – Glenbrook Road (near Castleman Building) pick-up at 1:10 pm; Plant and Soil Health Center (PSHC) pick-up at 2:50 pm (return trip).

There are no public parking lots directly at the venue location, please park in South Garage.

All parking on campus is by permit or payment for hourly parking ONLY. Surface lots marked with "P" are for employees and those without permits will be ticketed. Driving Directions to South Garage:

From Points East (I-95, I-395) • Follow signs on Route 44 West to Storrs (Mansfield) • Turn left onto Discovery Drive • Straight at the intersection with North Eagleville Rd. (Rt. 430) • In the roundabout, take the first exit onto Alumni Dr. • Turn left onto Jim Calhoun Way • Enter South Parking Garage on the right	From Points West (I-91, I-384, SR-32) • Follow signs on Route 44 East to Storrs (Mansfield) • Turn right onto Discovery Drive • Straight at the intersection with North Eagleville Rd. (Rt. 430) • In the roundabout, take the first exit onto Alumni Dr. • Turn left onto Jim Calhoun Way • Enter South Parking Garage on the right
From Points North (I-84) • I-84 to Exit 68 • Follow signs on Route 195 South to Storrs (Mansfield)	From Points South (I-95, I-395, US-6, SR-32) • Follow signs on Route 195 North to Storrs (Mansfield)

- Turn Left onto South Eagleville Road
- Turn right onto Jim Calhoun Way
- Enter South Parking Garage on the right



Park in South Garage and exit from the ground floor onto Jim Calhoun Way (directly across from Gampel Pavilion). Turn right and head northeast on Jim Calhoun Way towards Hillside Road. Cross Hillside Road towards the School of Business (on your left) and the Student Recreation Center (on your right). Turn left, with the Business School on your right. At the top of Fairfield Way (a pedestrian brick walkway in the heart of campus), turn right. ITE is on the right, just past the School of Business building. Walk over the Husky Mascot picture on Fairfield Way, turn right, walk up the stairs or use the ramp, to enter into the lobby/first floor of ITE. There's an additional first floor level entrance into ITE by Babbidge Library. ([UConn Map](#))
